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Purpose:

The Sampson County Partnership for Children strives to be a resource for families in need of diapers. Parents, grandparents or guardians may apply in-person on Wednesdays from 9AM-3PM. No appointment is necessary.

Requirements:

The child must be a resident of Sampson County. Proof of address is required. When applying, bring proof of the child's birthday (birth certificate, Medicaid card, etc.). The Diaper Bank will serve children birth through age 3. Once a child turns four, we will offer toilet-training resources. Families receiving EBT will be served first, followed by families receiving WIC or Medicaid. Diapers are distributed to approved families once per month while supplies last. The adult picking up diapers must have their Diaper Bank Card with them at each pick up. Anyone not picking up diapers for two consecutive months will be removed from the program. Any adult requesting diapers for a child over the age of 3 years and 11 months must have a documented medical need. Parents or guardians who receive diapers for their child agree to attend one Triple P Parenting Seminar during the year.
